

## **Invitation to interview staff: follow-up by telephone call**

Hello, my name is Nicola Mills. I am a researcher working on the Chlamydia Screening Study at the Department of Social Medicine, University of Bristol. The letter will have my telephone number on it or you can get it from the letter that you replied to. You can change your mind at any time and there's no problem if you do decide to change your mind.
